Membership

Membership is **FREE** to all residents of Kangaroo Island. A registration form is available from the Library and proof of ID is essential. Children under the age of 18 must have Parental/Guardian consent. Temporary memberships are also available on request.

If you are already a member of any other South Australian library you can borrow Library items, providing you have your Library card or Proof of ID.

One Card

Access millions of resources including books, magazines, DVD's and CD's across the state with a Kangaroo Island Library card. To do so you can browse the catalogue in the library or visit: www.kangarooisland.sa.gov.au/library and click on the catalogue link.



Enter your library card number and pin number to view your loans, place holds or extend items. If you don't know your pin contact the Library on 8553 4516 to reset.

Items can be borrowed and returned at any Public Library in South Australia. Up to 15 items can be borrowed at one time including books, DVD's, CD's or magazines.

E-Books

E-Books are available to download through the online Library catalogue. You will need the Overdrive media console, Libby or Bluefire reader app on your device to access. The E-Book service is compatible with most devices but not Kindle.

Online Resources

• RB digital magazines for Libraries

Visit the library catalogue and click on the RB digital banner to access over 400 full colour digital magazine titles. All borrowed items can be kept indefinitely, which means no overdue fees.

• Lynda Library

Lynda Library is a user-friendly online training resource. Access over 3500 courses that Lynda Library has to offer such as Microsoft Excel, Computer Literacy for Windows or Creating an effective resume.

The short segmented video tutorials ensure great usability at all internet speeds.

Library members can remotely access the site from anywhere in the state.
