

## Digital Audiobooks

Digital audio books will display with a headphone symbol.



Overdrive Media console or Libby software is required to access digital audiobooks.

Some audiobooks can be up to 500MB in size which is a factor to consider if you have a monthly download limit.

## Digital Magazines

Digital Magazines are available to download through the library network.

Magazines issues can be downloaded and kept indefinitely.

## Ebooks and Audiobooks

Ebooks and Audiobooks are available to download for free through the South Australian Public Library Network. Users must have a current South Australian Public Library card to access. The Ebook service is compatible with most devices but not Kindle due to licensing issues.

### What software will I need?

- The Overdrive media console App or Libby App is required to download audio books and Ebooks



Get the Overdrive media console or Libby app from your app store.

- The Bluefire Reader App is compatible to download both Overdrive and Wheelers Ebook titles on mobile devices.



Get the Bluefire Reader App from your app store.

- Adobe Digital Editions is required if downloading Ebooks and audiobooks on to a PC and will enable you to read on your PC or transfer books from the PC to other devices such as an Ereader.

Once the software is installed, Ebooks can be accessed in the following ways:

## 1. eResource Central (Library Catalogue)

eResource Central displays Ebooks and digital audiobooks within the Library Catalogue.

**1.1** Visit the Library catalogue at [www.kangarooisland.sa.gov.au/library](http://www.kangarooisland.sa.gov.au/library) and click on the catalogue link.

**1.2** To exclude regular material from your search, click on the drop down menu in the top left hand corner of the screen. Change the field from “Everything” to “Ebooks and Audiobooks”

**1.3** Click search to view all titles or enter an author or title in the search field and then click search.

All digital Ebook titles display as a grey book icon with an arrow.



**1.4** If an Ebook is available a preview and download option will display to the right of the title. Click on download. You will be prompted to enter a library card number and PIN

**1.5** If item is available select which format required.

- HTML (select this option to read in an internet browser-only able to read online)
- PDF, EPUB or adobe digital editions (select this option to download and read offline)

**1.6** If the item is checked out the download option will not display. Press Hold and enter your email address to be notified when it is available to borrow.

**1.7** To read the Ebook using Overdrive, open the Overdrive media console App on your device and click on bookshelf.

**1.8** To read Ebook using Bluefire Reader, the first time you download your EBook select ‘Open in Bluefire Reader’

## 2. Overdrive or Libby Apps

Overdrive Ebook titles can also be accessed by visiting <http://sapln.lib.overdrive.com/>



**2.1** Click on account and Login using your library card number and PIN.

**2.2** Browse titles by entering author/title in the search field or clicking on category eg: Fiction.

Available books will display with a black book icon in the corner. Unavailable books will display with a greyed out book icon.

**2.3** Click on title to borrow.

Open the Overdrive media console or Libby app to read.
