



Kangaroo Island Airport Management Committee - expression of interest for independent community members

Kangaroo Island, situated off the coast of South Australia, is unique in terms of its pristine environment, abundance of native wildlife and spectacular natural attractions. Kangaroo Island is recognised as the fourth tourism icon in Australia, and is the jewel in the crown for South Australia's tourism industry.

The Kangaroo Island Council owns and operates the Kangaroo Island (Kingscote) Airport.

The airport operates within the guidelines provided by Civil Aviation Safety Authority (CASA), other relevant agencies, Council Policies, Procedures, By-Laws and other relevant legislation.

The Council is seeking expressions of interest from members of the public who wish to assist Council with strategic inputs into the short, medium and long term operations of the airport, such as:

- Maintaining and improving airport infrastructure.
- Providing services and amenities for the improved use and enjoyment by users.
- Promoting interest for the development, growth and management of the airport and hinterland.
- Co-ordinating and facilitating efforts towards further development and growth of the airport.
- Advising on the management, operation and improvement of the airport.
- Considering and planning for the long term financial objectives of the airport.
- Generally furthering the aims and objectives of the Council.

In recent times the airport has undergone a major transformation with redevelopment of its terminal facilities and extension of runway – providing scope for larger commercial passenger aircraft direct from interstate. The airport upgrade is seen a potential game-changer for the Island in terms of providing for increased interstate and international visitation. Council is keen to attract independent persons to the Committee with skills and experience in aviation, airports, business and the like.

The Committee is an advisory Committee to provide advice and guidance to Council – the operations and management of the airport is overseen by operational staff. The Committee will meet up to 4 times per annum, on Kangaroo Island.

Council will reimburse members for travel and out of pocket expenses – no sitting fees apply.
