

DOGS BY-LAW 5

DETERMINATION OF ON LEASH, OFF LEASH AND DOG PROHIBITED AREAS

That Council:

1. Resolves that there are to be no designated off leash exercise areas established for the purpose of Part 4 Clause 9, of the Kangaroo Island Council Dogs By-Law No. 5 of 2017, effective from the date that commences operation.
2. Resolves that all fenced public parkland reserves; fenced / unfenced children's playground areas and all designated Council Campgrounds are to be designated on leash areas, in the interests of maintaining a high degree of safety for users of such public spaces, established for the purpose of Part 4 Clause 10, of the Kangaroo Island Council Dogs By-Law No. 5 of 2017, effective from the date that commences operation.
3. Resolves that there are to be no designated dog prohibited areas established for the purpose of Part 4 Clause 11, of the Kangaroo Island Council Dogs By-Law No. 5 of 2017, effective from the date that commences operation.
4. Acknowledges that in all other circumstances a person responsible for a dog, shall maintain that dog under effective control, being either (a) maintained on a leash appropriate for controlling the dog, or (b) under effective control of voice commands and maintained always within proximity that the dog hears and responds to command effectively.
