

Australian Government's \$100 million Mobile Coverage Programme Kangaroo Island Council needs your help!

The Commonwealth Government has made a funding commitment of \$100 million to improve mobile coverage and competition in regional and remote Australia, by investing in telecommunications network infrastructure.

The first step in this process is to develop a database of locations eligible for funding, based on the locations reported to the Department. To date, over 2,000 locations have been reported to the Department of Communications as having poor or no mobile phone coverage. Kangaroo Island Council wants to ensure Kangaroo Island is included in the Government's database and **we need your help to do this.**

- You have changed your address;
- You no longer live on Kangaroo Island;
- Your pet is owned by you but now resides at a different address (for example farm/business);
- Your pet has died; or
- You have given your pet to another person.

Council's Animal Management Team urges you to ensure your pets details are always current as this will ensure your pet can be returned to you as soon as possible if found.
